Ladies and Gentlemen,

I have a pleasure to invite you to participate in the celebration of **the International Electrician Day (MDE)**, which we celebrate every year on June 10. It is the feast of all engineers, technicians and other professionals involved in the broadly understood field of electrical engineering. This day is celebrated on the 10th anniversary of the death of the outstanding scientist André Marie Ampère (1775-1836), a French physicist and mathematician, considered today the founder of the foundations of electrodynamics, which is the basis of broadly understood electrical engineering. The name of the electric current unit comes from the scientist's name. Jacek Szpotański (1927-2019) - an outstanding activist of **the Association of Polish Electrical Engineers** (SEP) and its President in three terms – was the initiator of the International Electrician Day celebration.

This year, due to limitations in the organization of assemblies resulting from the coronavirus epidemic, the Board of SEP decided to organize MDE celebrations in the form of the online video conference call in virtual space - on the Internet.

Event date: 10th June 2020, at 11.00 am.

The extensive program of celebrations includes substantive lectures by Polish and foreign authors from France and the USA on selected electrical problems. An important MDE event is the presentation of the profile of the SEP 2020 patron - prof. Józef Węglarz. During the event, the results of two competitions will be announced: for the most active SEP Branch and a competition named after Prof. Mieczysław Pożaryski for the best article in the SEP technical press. This year's MDE celebration will feature a concert entitled "The most beautiful arias, duets and songs for electricians on their Christmas Day" - performed by artists from the European Vocal Foundation.
